Helen, one of our local Constables, visited Year 1 classes on Tuesday to discuss who the

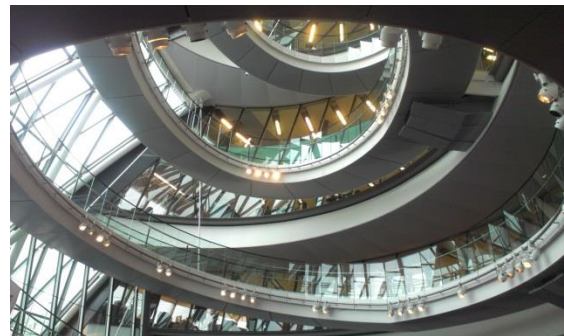
