Till they bloom bright and make you sing*

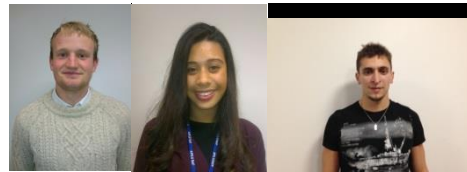
*Run to the hilltop,
